#### Rights

#### As an employee, you are entitled to:

- A written statement of your terms and conditions of employment
- Be paid at least the national minimum wage\*
- A wage statement or pay slip
- Paid holidays
- Statutory or contractual sick pay when off sick
- Not work more than 48 hours a week
- Have rest breaks
- Return to work after maternity, paternity, parental or adoption leave
- Paid time off work for ante-natal visit
- Safe and healthy working conditions
- Complain about poor treatment without being victimised
- Choose to join a trade union
- Be accompanied at a grievance or disciplinary hearing by a trade union representative or colleague

#### Wrongs

#### Your employer must not:

- Pay you less than the agreed amount for your work
- Fail to pay you for extra hours worked
- Force you to work against your will
- Make unfair or excessive deductions from your pay for transport or uniforms
- Put you at risk of injury or ill-health through your work
- Discriminate against you unlawfully
- Allow you to be threatened, harassed or bullied
- Ignore your complaints about poor treatment or treat you badly for raising a concern
- Dismiss you unfairly
- Treat you less favourably for being in a trade union
