

Olympic Games – TfL and Unions in Dispute

TfL vs. LUL pay offer

The table below compares the current TfL and LUL offers for Travel Ambassadors and office staff:

Staff category	Offer to TfL staff	Offer to LUL staff*
Staff who are considered 'core' (i.e. who continue to carry out their normal business critical role)	£0	3,500 TfL staff £850*
Staff who are not 'core' (i.e. are able to volunteer), but choose to come to work during the Games	£0	c. 2,500 TfL staff c.15,000 operational & maintenance staff c.2,000 Capital Projects staff in LUL
Staff who volunteer to be a TA Monday – Friday during office hours	£0	
Staff who volunteer to be a TA for one shift Monday to Friday evenings	£20	
Staff who volunteer to be a TA for one shift at the weekend	£30	
Staff who volunteer to be a TA for 20 shifts Monday to Friday evenings	£400	
Staff who volunteer to be a TA for 20 shifts, of which 12 are Mon-Fri evening and 8 are weekend	£480	

Please note, the above information is for Paybands 1 -3. For Paybands 4/5 there is no offer of any additional pay at all.
