Members will be aware that the union recently had sight of a leaked document produced by LUL, indicating that they plan cuts to ticket office opening hours, station staff and end round-the-clock station supervision.

RMT wrote to London Underground seeking assurances over these cuts. However, the company has failed to provide the necessary assurances: therefore the union is now in dispute on this matter.

LUL is about to unleash its plans for the future; these include station staff carrying iPads, so they can monitor other stations which are left un-staffed, thousands of job cuts across the company, and have continued to

not rule out the use of driverless trains.

RMT firmly believe that this constitutes a wholesale attack on London Underground jobs and services.

It is also a nightmare scenario for passengers and other London Underground staff who rely on station staff support.

Therefore a Special LUL members' rally has been arranged in defence of London Underground jobs and services and to discuss this dispute.
