Our backs are against the wall. The employers and their government are after everything we've got – our jobs, decent pay and pensions and even our trade union rights. Like Thatcher, the Con-Dems are pushing through their austerity offensive that is already ruining the NHS, education, the welfare state and public services. But it's the unions with still over 6 million members that potentially have the power to force Cameron and co back. That's why the NSSN has been campaigning for the union leaders to call a 24-hour general strike that can unite all those facing these brutal cuts.

We took up to 1,000 union activists to lobby the TUC conference last September, building support for the successful POA motion for the TUC to consider the practicalities of calling a general strike. It's not only practical but necessary – it's time to name the date!

The NSSN was initiated by the RMT transport union in 2006. Seven national unions – RMT, PCS, CWU, NUM, POA, NUJ and FRAWU – are either affiliated to the NSSN or officially support it as well as countless union branches, shop stewards committees and trades councils.

We support workers in struggle as well as those facing victimisation for the crime of defending their members from the employer's attacks. This conference is open to everyone in the unions and all those fighting these brutal cuts.
