We honour this date because of 23rd August 1791, a brave group of Afrikans on the island of San Domingo rose up and fought against the heinous crime of enslavement. More than one third of Afrikans died within a few years of being sent there. Led by, Toussaint L'Ouverture they defeated France, Spain and England. In 1804 the first Afrikan state out of continent of Afrika was created, called Haiti. Defeated France later demanded '150million francs' in retributions. "The conference is aimed at educating union members, in particular those in the Afrikan communities, their supporters and the wider Trade Union movement on history with insight into other aspects of Reparations. This is yet another opportunity for community groups and Trade Union movements to build closer links to the benefits both."
