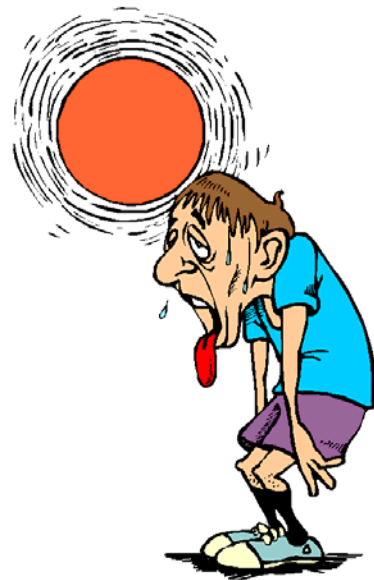
***If you can't stand the heat,
